
Online Survey




- Survey open two months; 1,109

- West Roseville, Lincoln, and Auburn had most responses




Geographic Reach







Rank Your Priorities








- Repaving/Fix Potholes








By the Numbers

- 1,109 online survey responses
- Ten pop-up events and informational meetings
 - PCTPA staff directly interacted with over 380 people
- Eight City/Town Council, Board of Supervisor, and Commission meetings
- 53 people attended virtual and in-person workshops
- 22,000 people saw boosted social media posts
- 10,000 e-mail inboxes received Constant Contact email blasts three times
- Animated promotional video developed by AIM with PCTPA staff that conveyed the RTP process in a fun and engaging manner
